**General Entrance Fee for First Arts is \$100 per semester per day. (i.e. Application fee is a one-time fee per occurrence of the class. Tuesday OR Thursday students will pay \$100 application fee, Tuesday AND Thursday students will pay \$200 application fee.)**

Base level class options are: Drama, Art, or Choir. You may select up to 2 of these options. All classes are in 30 minute blocks.

**Private music and voice lessons are available for an additional \$200 per semester per lesson. (i.e. A private lesson is a one-time cost per occurrence of the instruction. Tuesday OR Thursday students receiving private music instruction will pay \$200. Tuesday AND Thursday private lesson instruction will cost \$400.)**

Private lesson options are: Piano, Violin, Clarinet, Saxophone, Guitar, Electric Bass, Ukulele, or Voice. Don't see an instrument you'd like to learn? Email us, and we will try to accommodate you!!

# First Arts

## CODE OF CONDUCT

**First Arts, a ministry of First United Methodist Church Little Rock, has created a Code of Conduct in order to ensure that our space is a respectful, encouraging space for learning that promotes cooperation and thoughtfulness to enhance the experience for everyone involved.**

Students enrolled in First Arts are expected to be responsible, respectful, caring, trustworthy, hardworking and to model good citizenship. These expectations are defined below.

Responsible: Do what you are supposed to do. Take ownership for words and actions.

Respectful: Treat others as you want to be treated. Be considerate of others' feelings.

Caring: Kind and compassionate to others. Show you care.

Trustworthiness: Honest. Dependable.

Hardworking: We work with energy until the job is done.

Citizenship: Do your share to create success for everyone. Take care of what you are given. Contribute your part to the greater good.

**Our expectation is that students will follow verbal instructions from all adults; teachers and volunteers alike.** Failure to comply with verbal instruction will result in student's dismissal from the class or activity for the remainder of the lesson and an incident report will be sent home. In the event a second write-up is required in the same semester, the student will be dismissed from the First Arts program for the remainder of the semester.

**Church Van riders are expected to follow verbal instructions of the driver.** As the driver prepares students to board the bus, they should remain attentive and quiet. Students should board the vehicle in an orderly fashion. Students will fasten seat belts before vehicle leaves the school. While riding in the church van, refrain from screaming, fighting, unbuckling seat belts, eating or drinking. Students who do not comply with these expectations will be dismissed from the church van and will be taken to the school office and an incident report will be sent home. In the event a second write-up is required in the same semester, the student will be dismissed from the First Arts program for the remainder of the semester.

**The following behaviors will result in immediate expulsion from the First Arts program:**

Physical aggression toward another person, bullying, spitting, inciting or instigating violence, use of foul language or verbally abusing another person, vicious gossip, alienation of others, any other malicious acts, or willful destruction of property will result in immediate expulsion.
