



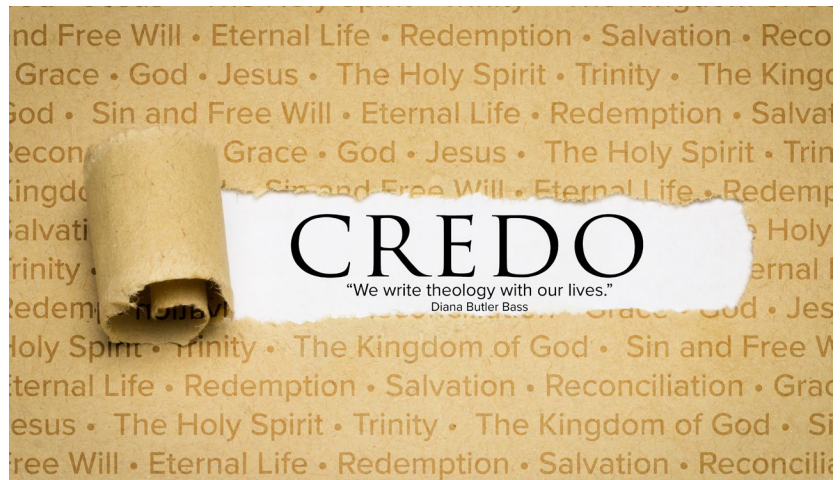

Credo – Lent 2024

“We write theology with our lives.” –Diana Butler Bass

If someone asked you what you believe in, could you tell them? Do you have a credo?

Credo is a Latin word that means “I believe,” and a credo is a statement of beliefs that guides our actions. And our life experiences shape what we believe. Yet, many people, even people who call themselves “religious,” rarely give thought to what they truly believe. But if our actions are guided by what we believe, wouldn’t it make our lives and decisions easier if we had a clear credo? And where did our beliefs come from? What shaped them?

This Lent, we are giving deep thought to our credos. Each Sunday, we’ll unpack a different tenant of Christianity like the Trinity, the Kingdom of God, Salvation, and Reconciliation. We’ll learn what these things mean and where we’ve seen them show up in our lives. Ultimately, we’ll discover how what we believe has shaped and continues to shape us. We hope this credo journey will lead us to a more profound understanding and experience of resurrection on Easter.
