SPEAK Truth in Love Opportunity

For several years, FUMCLR has sought to cultivate justice oriented voices in Little Rock and beyond. You may have recently seen several opportunities to petition for legislation that would support the THRIVEing of God's beloved children. The Unity Sunday School Class is sponsoring another opportunity on April 21 before and after worship:

The education rights amendment of 2024 is sponsored by For AR Kids, a coalition of organizations including the AEA, ARTA, the Arkansas chapter of the NAACP, Arkansans for World-Class Education, Citizens First Congress, and the Arkansas Public Policy Panel.

The proposed amendment would:

1) Require any school receiving state funds to follow the same standards that public schools have to follow (think transportation, lunches , and teacher certification, to name a few).

2) Establish the minimum standards ordered by the Arkansas Supreme Court in the Lakeview decision.

3) Guarantee universal access to pre K 3 and 4, after school and summer programming, and funding for special education.
